<p>To explain the concept of banking and bank accounts.</p> <p>To explain the different sorts of bank accounts.</p> <p>To encourage students to shop around for the best deals.</p>	<p><b>Suggested activity</b></p> <p><b>Activity 1</b> Banking Basics - Research and compare current and savings accounts from four local banks or building societies.</p> <p>This can be done by visiting each bank and asking counter staff and collecting leaflets giving details. Or you may find the internet can give you answers via each bank's website.</p> <p><b>Suggested handouts</b> Practical tips when opening a bank account</p> <p>Debit card handout</p> <p>Cheque handout</p> <p><i>Brainstorm, class work, pair work or home work.</i></p> <p><b>Banking Quiz</b></p>	<p>Students will be able to recognise the different types of bank accounts.</p> <p>Students will know how to open a bank or building society account if they choose to do so.</p> <p>Students will understand the range of services offered by banks that can give them better control over their money.</p> <p>Students will have an understanding of what all the different services are and be able to make informed choices on which account or bank is suitable for them.</p>
